2. The results of the interview are as follows:

- a. Sgt BATTAGLIA demonstrated outstanding growth potential as a commissioned officer.
- b. The applicant expressed himself with confidence, maturity and in a relaxed manner. His thought process is logical and thorough. It was immediately apparent during the interview that Sgt BATTAGLIA pursues what he perceives as right and just with all possible vigor. He is a determined individual who has methodically prepared himself to achieve established goals. His manner reflects a natural leadership ability which should enable him to readily adjust to rapidly changing situations.
- c. Sgt BATTAGLIA has scored First Class on the PFT each time tested for the past two and one half years. His personal appearance is exemplary and his military presence outstanding.
- d. In the course of the interview it was learned that Sgt BATTAGLIA has begun work on a Masters Degree in his off duty time.

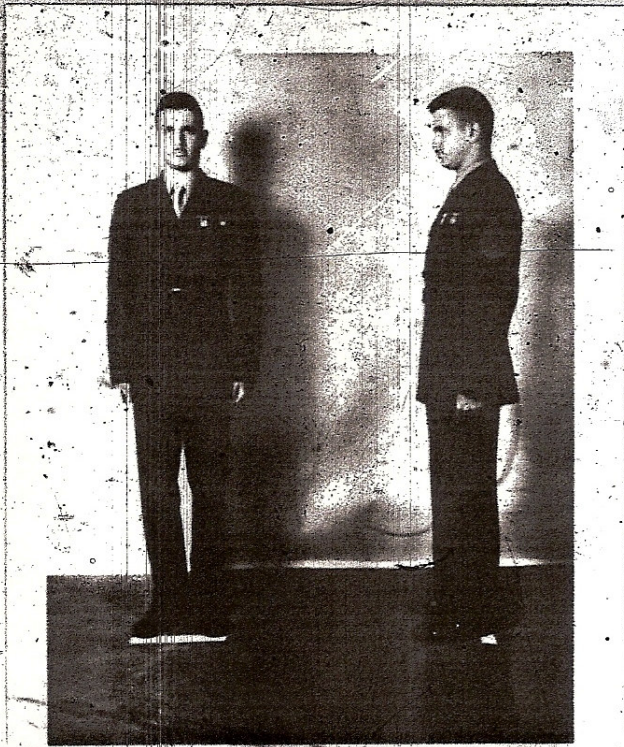
